## Economic Responsibility:

1. Sightseeing tours are operated and led by local guides. Also, we use local drivers, and local staff make all tour arrangements.

2. We encourage clients to buy handmade artifacts from local producers, like perfume, papyrus, carpets, and pharaonic gold or silver souvenirs.

3. We are interested in training our local staff by giving them leadership courses, emotional intelligence courses, and language courses in addition to tourism courses.
